Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Navarro River watershed, approximately 4 miles southeast of the town of Navarro, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 26, T15N, R15W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Bailey Ridge U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0661-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mr. Michael Croft.

The project is limited to five (5) encroachments. Three (3) encroachments are to upgrade undersized culverts. One (1) encroachment is for replacement of the outlet of an existing pond. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

One (1) encroachment is for maintenance of an existing stream crossing culvert and installation of a rock apron at the outlet.
