Project Title: Anderson Stream Crossing and Pond Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-13374-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 4 miles northwest of the town of Covelo, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 27, T23N, R13W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Covelo West U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-13374-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Scott Anderson.

The project is limited to four (4) encroachments. Three (3) encroachments are to upgrade undersized and/or failing culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new appropriately-sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. One (1) encroachment is to install a rock apron downstream from the outlet culvert of an existing pond, and remove diversion infrastructure. Water will not be diverted from the pond for consumptive use.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as in the Lead Agency / in a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
