**Project Title:** Baker Crossings, Onstream Pond Bypass, and Stream Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-18000-R1C)

**Project Location:** The project is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 9.62 miles west of the town of Leggett, County of Mendocino, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 056-130-05 and 056-120-06; latitude 39.8552 N and longitude -123.5308 W at the first crossing.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 7 encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from Twin Rock Creek. Water is diverted for esthetics. Encroachment 2 is for work for the water diversion which will include installing bypass structures, use, and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure or rendering the pond incapable of storing water. The 5 other proposed encroachments are to upgrade or remove failing and undersized stream crossings and stream restoration. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring, and revegetation with natives as necessary to minimize erosion.
