Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 6.6 miles northeast of the town of Covelo, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 24, T 23N, R 12W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Covelo East U.S. Geological Survey 7.5minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 032-170-42; latitude 39.8436 N and longitude 123.1422 W at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-07113-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Colin Belinger.

The project is limited to three encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from Williams Creek. Water is diverted for irrigation and stored in an off-stream reservoir with a spillway that drains towards a nearby stream. Work for the water diversion will include removing the existing water diversion, replacement with new water diversion infrastructure consistent with this Agreement and use and maintenance of the water diversion. The two other proposed encroachments are to upgrade existing culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
