Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Russian River watershed, approximately 2.5 miles north of the town of Redwood Valley, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 29, T 17N, R 12W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Redwood Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 161-010-04; latitude 39.3007 N and longitude 123.2144 W at the stream crossing.
