Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Lake Mendocino-East Fork Russian River watershed, approximately three miles southeast of the town of Redwood Valley, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 12, T16N, R12W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Redwood Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 176-020-12; latitude 39.26179 N and longitude 123.14804 W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-29636-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Stephen Krueger. This Agreement relies on the Notification materials and a subsequent CDFW site inspection on September 22, 2022. The project is limited to one (1) encroachment to replace two 30-inch double barrel culverts with a seasonal rock ford crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, and installation of a rock ford crossing. The crossing shall accommodate the estimated 100-year flood flow, including debris and sediment. The final construction plans for the rock ford crossing shall be submitted to CDFW for review and acceptance within three (3) months from the effective date of this Agreement, after which the Permittee shall allow 60 days for CDFW review and acceptance prior to project implementation. The Notification also disclosed one well, located at 39.25973, -123.14380, used for cannabis irrigation.
