**Project Title:** Clayburg Stream Crossing (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0845-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 13 miles north of the town of Laytonville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 33, T24N, R15W, Mt. Diablo Meridian; Assessor's Parcel 056-030-05; latitude 39.88099 N and longitude 123.53391 W.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 1 encroachment (Table 1) to upgrade a low water crossing to a rocked ford that will be crossed by Jeep and on foot.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
