Project Title: Bolin Stream Crossings Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0373-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Russian River watershed, approximately 5.5 miles south southwest of the town of Willits, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 14, T17N, R14W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Greenough Ridge U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 147-052-09; latitude 39.3325 N and longitude -123.3834 W at one of the stream crossings.

Project Description: The project is limited to three (3) encroachments (Table 1) for work on stream crossings. Two proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. One encroachment is to add rock to an existing culvert at the inlet and outlet. The Notification also discloses the use of a well located at Lat./Long.: 39.33.25, -123.3825. This well is presented as the sole source of water for all needs on the property. CDFW did not evaluate hydraulic connection of the well to surface water, nor was a hydrogeologic evaluation prepared by a licensed geologist provided for CDFW review. The Notification also discloses a small pond and a surface water spring located at Lat./Long.: 39.3320, -123.3826. These features will be evaluated during a CDFW site inspection, and if work is determined to be necessary, the Permittee shall notify pursuant to FGC 1602. No water diversion from these sites is authorized by this Agreement. No other projects that may be subject to FGC1602 were disclosed. This Agreement does not retroactively permit any stream crossings, water diversions or other encroachments not described above.

Crossing-1	39.3315, -123.3849	Install rock armor at inlet and outlet of 12" diameter culvert that is currently functioning. When culvert replacement is deemed necessary at a later date, replace with minimum 18" diameter culvert. All irrigation line shall be removed from the culvert and stream channel.
Crossing-2	39.3325, -123.3834	Replace undersized 12" diameter culvert with minimum 18" diameter culvert. All irrigation line shall be removed from the culvert and stream channel.
Crossing-3	39.3320, -123.3826	Replace undersized 12" diameter culvert with minimum 24" diameter culvert. All irrigation line shall be removed from the culvert and stream channel.
