Project Description: The Chemistry Alterations 1 project is a component of the larger Bainer Hall and Chemistry Complex Addition and Renovation Project. The Chemistry Alterations 1 project renovates approximately 5,500 gross square feet of the Chemistry Building to accommodate a new receiving and store room for Supply Change Management, consolidates and relocates the existing Machine Shop, and creates a new hallway to Chemistry that aligns with the exterior doors in Chemistry Annex. The project also finishes the two-story atrium shelled space from the Chemistry Annex Seismic project.

This Notice of Determination is to advise that the University of California Lead Agency has approved the above-described project on June 16, 2022 and has made the following determinations:

For an Addendum to an EIR:

1. *Addendum February 2019* to the UC Davis 2018 Long Range Development Plan (LRDP) EIR (SCH# 2017012008) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
2. UC Davis 2018 LRDP EIR sufficiently analyzes and addresses potential environmental impacts from the project, and the project will not trigger any of the criteria requiring additional CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162. The project will not result in new significant impacts or a substantial increase in the severity of the environmental impacts identified in the UC Davis 2018 LRDP EIR.
3. Mitigation measures from the UC Davis 2018 LRDP EIR were made a condition of the approval of the project; no new project-specific mitigation measures are required.
4. The implementation of applicable 2018 LRDP Final EIR mitigation measures will be monitored and reported pursuant to the 2018 LRDP Final EIR’s Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program.
5. The previous statement of overriding considerations in the 2018 LRDP Final EIR was reaffirmed for this project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
