The proposed uses would be 1) an extension of the BayHealth Outpatient Center with an Oncology laboratory and in Suite 180 and 2) R&D, office, and laboratory uses within Suite 200. The combined square footage of the two suites is 87,495 square feet. Portions of the building are in three cities: Berkeley, Oakland and Emeryville. An executed Memorandum of Understanding (April 2013) between the Cities of Oakland, Emeryville and Berkeley establishes Berkeley as the lead city for land use approvals.
