**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) is the responsible agency. The SWRCB's Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) Program is providing state funds for the project. The Mojave Public Utilities District (PUD) proposes to repair existing structures, no ground disturbance and no expansion of existing use on the existing Mojave PUD facility.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The SWRCB has approved the project described above on April 9, 2019 and has determined that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Mojave Public Utilities District PUD will be carrying out the project.
