Project Location (include county): The Project site is in the central portion of the Coachella Valley in the city of Palm Desert in Riverside County. The Project site is located within the Whitewater River Stormwater Channel, located between Cook Street and Fred Waring Drive.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0085-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Coachella Valley Water District.

The Project involves the construction of three erodible earthen berms placed across the bottom of the Whitewater River Stormwater Channel to serve as groundwater replenishment basins. Colorado River Water will be used to fill the replenishment basins. The berms tie into a reinforced concrete diversion structure at the northernly concrete-lined embankment of the Whitewater River Stormwater Channel. The concrete diversion structure allows low flows which exceed the capacity of the ponds to bypass the facility.
