SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108

Project Title: Rollins Stream Crossing, Stream Crossings Decommissioning, and Water Diversion (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-20037-R1C)

Project Location: The project is located within the Salmon Creek watershed, approximately 9 miles northwest of the town of Redway, County of Humboldt, State of California; Section 10, T03S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 221-061-041-000; latitude 40.2112 N and longitude -123.9347 W at the culvert replacement. A Point of Diversion (POD) occurs on APN 221-061-039-000; latitude 40.2151 N and longitude 123.9377 W; place of use for POD occurs on APN 221-061-041-000. The off-parcel POD was the only project evaluated on the adjacent parcel.

Project Description: The project is limited to four (4) encroachments (Table 1). One (1) encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to Salmon Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Two (2) encroachments include the decommissioning of stream crossings. One (1) proposed encroachment is to upgrade a failing and undersized stream crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
