**File No.:** PL17-0042.DM01 (Special Conditional Use Permit – Developer Modification), PL17-0044.DM01 (Site Approval – Developer Modification) and Addendum to the Altitude Business Centre Environmental Impact Report for the In-N-Out Distribution Center (SCH No. 2017051060)

Proposal/Environmental Determination: A request to modify a portion of a previously approved industrial park to allow for the construction of an In-N-Out Burgers distribution facility consisting of a 284,996 square foot distribution/processing building, 24,429 square foot fleet maintenance building, 66,779 square foot sharehouse/cookout building, and other ancillary buildings including a waste water treatment building and guard houses on a 25.97 acre site located in the AR (Airport Related) land use designation of The Preserve Specific Plan. An the Altitude Business Centre Environmental Addendum to Impact Report (SCH No. 2017051060) for the In-N-Out Distribution Center has been prepared for this project pursuant to Section 15164 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines. The project is within the scope of the EIR, which adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA.
