Project Title: South of Tioga (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2018-078-04 (ITP))

Project Location: The South of Tioga development (Project) is within the city limits of Sand City, Monterey County, California, at the intersection of California and Tioga avenues, approximately 600 feet east of State Route 1 at approximately 36.6156, -121.8465.

Project Description: The Project consists of a six-parcel, vesting tentative map application (including roadway abandonment and dedications and lot mergers), site plan review, architectural review, and conditional use permits. Development of the Project will consist of a multi-family residential building containing up to 420 units, a separate 216-room hotel, and a restaurant. A 0.9-acre dune area supporting approximately 22,000 individuals will be placed under a conservation easement.

The Project will permanently remove 0.3 acre of Monterey gilia (*Gilia tenuiflora* ssp. *arenaria*) habitat supporting approximately 35 germinated individuals. Monterey gilia is designated as a threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
