**Project Title:** State Route 58 Trout Creek Bridge Replacement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0136-R4)

**Project Location:** The Project will occur in the Trout Creek channel near where it flows towards the Salinas River beneath State Route 58 approximately two miles east of the town of Santa Margarita, San Luis Obispo County. The Project involves construction within the banks of the channel along a 315-foot reach of Trout Creek and outside of the stream - including 426 feet of drainage ditches parallel to the road along State Route 58. The Project Site is located within Section 21, Township 29 South, Range 13 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian.

**Project Description:** The Project involves utility relocation, the replacement of the existing State Route 58 bridge over Trout Creek, the recontouring of two roadside drainage ditches outside of the stream, and the replacement of armoring within the stream.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 11/7/19 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
