Project Location: The Project is located at 262 Castro Canyon Road (Latitude 34.88097, Longitude -119.62165; Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 149-140-074) in New Cuyama, Santa Barbara County, California, 93254. The parcel is bisected by a well-defined unnamed ephemeral stream. The unnamed stream ends in the cultivated agricultural lands about 2 miles north of the parcel.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-24983-R5 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Moe Essa. The project is the cultivation of outdoor cannabis in hoop houses totaling 3.62 acres with supporting uses including installation of a geocell and rock road base over the existing culvert that provides access to the project for stabilization reinforcement.
