Project Title: Flood System Repair Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0052-R3)

Project Location: Project is located in Sacramento County, State of California, Latitude 38.086390°N and Longitude -121.708035°W; Section 24, T3N, R2E, U.S. Geological Survey map Jersey Island.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0052-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Reclamation District No. 341, as represented by Juan Mercado, Jr.

Project is limited to rehabilitation of the waterside levee between approximate levee stations 945+50 and 950+50 on Sherman Island along Horseshoe Bend of the Sacramento River. The project will repair the levee to meet current U.S. Army Corps of Engineers standards, install rock slope protection along approximately 500 linear feet of the waterside levee slope, and restore habitat on the waterside levee slope. Repair work will be confined to the water side of the levee. No dewatering/diversion is proposed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on March 12, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
