## **CEQA – NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

This Notice is being filed in compliance with Section 21108 and 21152 of the Public Resources Code.

Mitigated Negative Declaration, New Student Union Project - September 2019

#### **Project Description**:

The California State University (CSU) Fresno Campus Master Plan, adopted by the Trustees of the California State University in 2011, addressed all aspects of future physical development and land use on the campus to accommodate the approved enrollment capacity of 25,000 full-time equivalent students (FTES).

The campus proposes revisions to the 2011 Campus Master Plan to accommodate one new facility, the New Student Union (Project). The Project would involve the construction of a new, approximately 80,000 gross-square-foot (GSF) building, as well as outdoor plazas, lawn areas, and an amphitheater to provide engaging and flexible spaces that accommodate a wide range of uses, on an approximately 3.4-acre site in the center of campus near the Henry Madden Library. The Project site is currently occupied by two existing facilities that would be demolished to accommodate the Project: the existing Keats building built in 1956 (7,400 GSF), which occupies the northern portion of the Project Site, and the 1963 open-air amphitheater (approximately 47,000 SF) and stage (3,000 SF), which occupy the central portion of the Project Site.

The New Student Union would support student life and dining, including the needs of over 24,000 students and 270 clubs, student government, and would complement the existing University Student Union and Satellite Student Union. Utility infrastructure improvements, as well as new lighting and landscaping, would also be provided. The Project does not include additional parking facilities.

In accordance with CEQA, an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) was prepared to analyze the potential environmental effects associated with the New Student Union Project. Per CEQA, an IS/MND may be prepared for a project subject to CEQA if an initial study (IS) has identified potentially significant effects on the environment, but (1) revisions in the project plans or proposals made by, or agreed to by, the project proponent before the proposed MND and IS are released for public review would avoid the effects or mitigate the effects to a point in which clearly no significant effect on the environment would occur; and (2) there is no substantial evidence in light of the whole record before the public agency that the project, as revised, may have a significant effect on the environment (California Public Resources Code, Section 21064.5).

The analysis presented in the IS/MND concluded that the Project would result in potentially significant effects on the environment, but that with incorporation of required mitigation measures into the Project, all potentially significant effects would be reduced to a less than significant level. Accordingly:

- 1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the approval of the Project.
- 4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted for this Project.
- 5. A statement of Overriding Considerations is not required to be adopted for this Project.
- 6. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

Therefore, the California State University as the lead agency has approved the above-described Project on September 25, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the Project:

- 1. The IS/MND for the New Student Union Project addressed the potential significant environmental impacts, mitigation measures, comments, and responses to comments associated with the New Student Union Project and all discretionary actions related thereto.
- 2. The Board of Trustees of the California State University considered the IS/MND prior to its action approving the Project.
