**PROJECT LOCATION:** The wastewater treatment plant is located at 21111 Black Ranch Road, Burney, California. Public Land Survey location: Section 9 of Township 35 North, Range 3 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The proposed project entails sewer system improvements in the unincorporated community of Burney, including improvements to the existing wastewater treatment plant, Main Lift Station, and Bartel Lift Station; repair of approximately four manholes; replacement of approximately 1,700 linear feet of damaged pipeline; and repair of approximately 40 pipeline mechanical deficiencies to eliminate cracked pipe, offset joints, etc.

This is to advise that the State Water Board made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations and approved CWSRF financing on April 29, 2020 for the Project:
