The TOD Plans provide for a net increase of 4,090 dwelling units and 705,976 s.f. of commercial uses. The Plans include land use and

development regulations, as well as design guidelines providing for intensification of development within walking distance of transit, along with plans for public improvements. The TOD Plans define and implement the City's vision to increase housing, employment, and commercial opportunities; enhance economic vitality; and protect existing neighborhoods.
