Project Location (include county): The project is approximately 1.25 miles north of Covelo, at the crossing of Mill Creek by State Highway 162, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 31, Township 23N, Range 12W; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Covelo East, Calif. U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle. Latitude 39.8113°, Longitude -123.24814°.
