Project Title: Francisco Blvd. West Multi-Use Pathway: 2nd to Anderson (Major Amendment to Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0041-R3)

Project Location: Project is located along Francisco Blvd. West Between 2nd Street and Anderson Drive in San Rafael, in the County of Marin. The approximate project centroid is Latitude 37.96639°N, Longitude 122.5175°W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Major Amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0041-R3 (Agreement), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of San Rafael, Department of Public Works.

The overarching project consists of the construction of a multi-use pathway from Anderson Drive to the existing San Rafael Creek pathway. In April 2020, the project was amended to reduce the length of sheetpile retaining wall from 1,314 to approximately 899 linear feet, remove the extension of an existing culvert at Irwin Street, and include the movement of an existing trash rack approximately 285 feet upstream.

This major amendment reduces the amount of habitat restoration and enhancement to mitigate impacts from the project. Due to previous reductions in project impacts, the total mitigation to impact ratio required in the Agreement has increased.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on June 3, 2021, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
