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Remove infrastructure comprising of Roy's Pools fish ladder and sheet metal weirs and create a new channel gradient with engineered streambed materials to allow fish passage and hydraulic connectivity through the project area. Removal of trees and replacement of failing pedestrian bridge in the same location. Create floodplain and off-channel habitat through grading of adjacent land surfaces. Revegetate disturbed areas with native seeds, plants and trees.

Design Review and Tree Removal Permit

Design Review approval to replace an existing wooden bridge with a new prefabricated steel truss bridge. The bridge will span San Geronimo Creek at length of 78 feet 6 inches by 12 feet. The bridge will also include a 4-foot-tall safety railing. Other restoration efforts associated with the Roy's Pools Fish Passage and Floodplain Restoration Project would result in the removal of 51 protected trees and seven heritage trees. The proposed tree replacement is associated with riparian habitat restoration that would include extending the riparian corridor, removing invasive plant species, and planting thousands of native's plants and trees.

The Department of Public Works Agency Director approved the creek permit for the project on April 23, 2020 and the Community Development Agency Director has approved the Design Review and Tree Removal Permit for the project on April 13, 2020. This is to advise that on April 23, 2020, Marin County, acting as a Responsible Agency under CEQA, has reviewed and considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, and has adopted the Lead Agency's following determinations regarding the project as described above:

- 1. The project will not have significant effects on the environment.
- 2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared by the lead agency pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted for this project.
- 5. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
- 6. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
