The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Chicago District, is releasing for public review, the "Westminster East Garden Grove, California Flood Risk Management Study Integrated Feasibility Report and Environmental Impact Statement/Draft Environmental Impact Report."

The integrated feasibility report and environmental impact statement/draft environmental impact report (IFR and EIS/Draft EIR) analyzes the results of the Westminster, East Garden Grove, California Flood Risk Management Study within the Westminster watershed. This study is being conducted by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in partnership with Orange County (OC) Public Works. Significant and unavoidable environmental effects resulting from the project include air quality and noise. The project site is not on a list enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.
