Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to Ramsey Street Wash on the south side of Interstate Highway 10 (I-10) and one mile east of Hargrave Street within the City of Banning in the County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.92441^o N, Longitude 116.84471^o W. Sections 11 and 14, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Cabazon, San Bernardino Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0254-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Banning Industrial LP.

The Project is limited to the construction of a warehouse, parking lot, and two stormwater basins, the extension of John Street to reach the Project Site, construction of a gravel emergency access road, installation of water and sewer lines, construction of an associated new sewer pump station, and the diversion of two drainages. The extension of John Street will cross four drainages and culverts will be installed at each drainage. A gravel low-water crossing will be installed at Ramsey Street Wash. Two drainages will be redesigned to avoid the warehouse structure.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 21, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
