The Parks Master Plan includes goals, policies and actions for the provision of parks and recreational services, as well as, general recommendations for expanded recreational uses and specific recommendations for improvements at the City's individual parks, beaches, open spaces, and recreational facilities. The Parks Master Plan lays out recommendations for the next 15 years but is designed to be updated over time, providing a guiding framework while allowing for adjustments based on both presently anticipated and unforeseen future needs and community desires.
