SUBJECT: CEQA ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT FILING FEE PAYMENT

Completion of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review process for an Environmental Impact Report requires filing of a fee with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

On April 15, 2021, the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Board (Central Coast Water Board) adopted Resolution No. R3-2021-0039, which certified the Environmental Impact Report for the General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from Irrigated Lands in the Central Coast Region. Consequently, we are required to pay an Environmental Filing Fee to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
