The University has determined that an updated LRDP must be prepared to better reflect the revised campus site and changed conditions in the area. A Recirculated Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) has been prepared to evaluate the potentially significant environmental effects of the proposed UC Merced 2020 LRDP.
