The Project also includes moving an existing rate control station currently located below ground at the corner of 25th Avenue and East 29th Street onto the Project site. The current access road around the reservoir perimeter would be retained and improved. The Project will also remove vegetation, replace security fencing, and restore and landscape the site following construction. The Project also includes an access driveway to connect the Redwood Day School parking area to
