**Project Location:** The Project will occur at five culverts which channel surface water in tributaries to the Middle Fork Stanislaus River under State Route 108 approximately 2.8 miles east of the community of Dardanelle in Tuolumne County.

**Project Description:** In general, the Project Activities will involve the replacement of five culvert facilities, the installation of RSP at two Locations, dewatering at each Location, and restoration seeding/planting within disturbed areas. Amendment No. 1 describes a previously uncontemplated work window, allowing Caltrans to perform Project Activities beginning on May 1.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 4/27/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
