**Project Title:** Newtown Road Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. ELD-31735-R2

**Project Location (include county):** The Newtown Road Bridge is located south of the community of Camino in unincorporated El Dorado County. Latitude 38.707466, Longitude -120.681808.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number ELD-31735-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, El Dorado County.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of the existing bridge at South Fork Weber Creek. The replacement bridge will be installed on the same location using a precast arch bridge supported on spread footings. The new bridge will be approximately 192 feet long, 6 feet tall, and have an approximately 23-foot span. The replacement bridge will include three (3) wing walls and one retaining wall armored with rock slope protection.
