The Project is a partnership between the MRCA and the County of Los Angeles (landowner). The Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts currently operates the site. The proposed improvements include a 2.5-mile loop trail and regional connection, flush toilets, picnic tables, native planting, fitness stairs, interpretive elements, gates, fencing, and other amenities.
