Project Title: Dillard Road Bridge Critical Scour (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0106-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at the Cosumnes River, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.491367, Longitude 121.161565, Section 1, Township 7N, Range 7E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Sloughhouse, approximately 0.1 miles south of the intersection of Dillard Road and Jackson Road.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0106-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sacramento County Department of Transportation, as represented by Mike Meschi.

The project will address scour around existing piers and abutments at the Dillard Road Bridge. The purpose of the project is to provide scour counter measures for Pier 3, and to establish a scour monitoring program for Abutments 1 and 6, and Piers 2, 4, and 5. Scour counter measures include the installation of 306 cubic yards of rock slop protection.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 08/16/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
