Project Title: Soldier Creek Sediment Reduction and Salmonid Recovery Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0617-R1)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located in Mendocino County, California on Soldier Creek, at 39.86061 north latitude, -123.82399 west longitude at the center of the work area on the mainstem of Soldier Creek; Hales Grove 7.5 Minute U.S. Geological Survey Quadrangle map. Streamside road removal will occur on the mainstem Soldier Creek for approximately 2.48 stream miles.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0167-R1, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Trout Unlimited.

Decommission 2.48 miles of road including treatment of 12 site-specific erosional features preventing 2,750 cubic yards of sediment from entering the stream system.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency, approved the above described project on 08/05/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project:
