

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (MND) 2339 TRACT MAP 36647 AND EAST DETENTION BASIN

Project Location - City: Perris

Project Location - County: Riverside

Project Location - Specific: The project site is located north of I-215, north of Ramona Expressway, between Evans Road and the Perris Valley Storm Drain. The site currently consists of three (3) parcels (APNs: 302-150-009, 019, and 302-140003, 004, and 007).) that total approximately 53 acres.

Description of the Project: A General Plan Amendment to change the General Plan Land Use element from Specific Plan to R-6 6000, and a Change of Zone from R-10,000 to R-6000 to support Tr. 36647, a subdivision of 24.12 gross acres into 90 single family lots having a lot size of 6000 sf, together with an approximately 29 acre East Drainage Basin. The East Basin is a flood control facility to capture flow out of the Perris Valley Storm Drain when it reaches capacity. The excavation of the basin will involve 400,000 cubic yards of soil which is excavated from the 29-acre property to the south of Tr. 36648 in Phase 1 (Interim Basin); and 200,000 cubic yards of export from the same location in Phase 2 (Ultimate Basin) for a total of 600,000 cubic yards.

Mitigation Measures: The Initial Study evaluated potential environmental impacts to aesthetics, agricultural and forestry resources, air quality, biological resources, cultural and paleontological resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use, planning, population and housing, mineral resources, noise, public services and utilities, recreation and parks, and traffic and circulation. Of all potential effects evaluated, impacts in the area of biology, cultural, hydrology, noise, and transportation and traffic were identified, but will be reduced to less than significant levels with implementation of mitigation measures identified in the Initial Study. The City did not identify any significant, unavoidable impacts.
