Project Title: Bachelor Creek Bridge Project EA: 01-0F490 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0194-R2).

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at post mile 5.8 of State Route (SR) 20 on Bachelor Creek, a tributary to Clear Lake; approximately 2.46 miles west of the highway 20/29 roundabout intersection in Lake County, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0194-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, State of California Department of Transportation. The Project is limited to replacing three existing corrugated metal pipes with two precast reinforced concrete box culverts and associated headwalls.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
