Project Title: 700 Crocker Drive (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0274-R3)

Project Location: The Project is located at Gibson Canyon Creek, in the County of Solano, State of California; approximately Latitude 38° 24' 56.73" N, Longitude 121° 56' 50.24" W. The address is 700 Crocker Drive in the City of Vacaville.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0274-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, LDK Ventures.

The Project includes installation of two box culvert crossings at separate locations on Gibson Canyon Creek, installation of three outfall culverts, bank stabilization, vegetation removal, and undergrounding of a portion of Solano Irrigation District Kilkenny Canal.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on March 13, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
