
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0358-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Pleasant Hill.

The project is limited to the following activities: replacement of three existing stormwater pipe outfalls and installation of a new storm drain system that includes a new bio-retention basin and 100 and 500-year flood retention on a new sports field

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on April 27, 2020, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
