Project Location:

The project is located in El Dorado County within the Lake Tahoe Basin. The Project area is within an existing residential subdivision known as Tahoe Paradise, located along Ofl yng Drive from Southern Pines Drive to the intersection with Pioneer Trail in El Dorado County, California. The Project's border is Skyline Drive to the north, Elks Club Drive to the east, Pioneer Trail to the south, and Southern Pines Drive to the west. Specifically the Project is located in Sections 20, 21, 28, and 29 in Township 12 North and Range 18 East (Mt. Diablo Meridian). The long-term license agreement includes five California Tahoe Conservancy (Conservancy) parcels within the project area (El Dorado County Assessment Numbers 081-092-009, 081-092-010, 081-111-012, 034-772-020, and 034-761-008), as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

Project Description:

The primary goal of the project is ecosystem and watershed management. El Dorado County intends to implement a water quality project along Pioneer Trail from Elks Club Drive to Southern Pines, to reduce and treat storm water runoff from the subdivision before it reaches the Upper Truckee River, Trout Creek, and Lake Tahoe. The project proposes to stabilize eroding slopes and channels, and install infiltration basins, swales, and pipes.

This is to advise that the Conservancy, acting as a responsible agency, has approved the above described project on June 20, 2019 [Agenda Item 7] and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A mitigated negative declaration (MND) for the project was prepared and approved by El Dorado County on February 26, 2019, and a NOD was filed on February 26, 2019.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the approval of the project by El Dorado

County and the Conservancy.

4. A mitigation monitoring plan was adopted for this project.





NOTICE

Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 7 categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, if not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the fee in § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5, subd. (g)(1)). A county board of supervisors may charge, that is otherwise authorized to be levied by another provision of law, in the amount reasonable for any product or service or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee or charge is levied.

COLLECTION PROCEDURES FOR COUNTY GOVERNMENT

Filing Notice of Determination (NOD):

- Collect environmental filing fee or copy of previously issued cash receipt. (Do not collect fee if a No Effect Determination signed by CDFW. An additional fee is required for each separate environmental document. Checks should be made payable to the county.)
- Issue cash receipt to project applicant.
- Attach copy of cash receipt and, if applicable, previously issued cash receipt, to NOD.
- Mail filing fees for CRP document to CDFW prior to filing the NOD or equivalent final approval (Cal. Code Regs. Tit. 14, § 753.5 (b)(5)). The CRP should request receipt from CDFW to show proof of payment for filing the NOD or equivalent approval. Please mail payment to address below made attention to the Cash Receipts Unit of the Accounting Services Branch.

If the project applicant presents a No Effect Determination signed by CDFW, also:

- Attach No Effect Determination to NOD (no environmental filing fee is due).

Filing Notice of Exemption (NOE) (Statutorily or categorically exempt project (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15260-15285, 15300-15333))

- Issue cash receipt to project applicant.
- Attach copy of cash receipt to NOE (no environmental filing fee is due).

Within 30 days after the end of each month in which the environmental filing fees are collected, each county shall summarize and record the amount collected on the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31) and remit the amount collected to the State Treasurer. Identify the remittance on Form No. CA25 as "Environmental Document Filing Fees" per Fish and Game Code section 711.4.

The county clerk shall mail the following documents to CDFW on a monthly basis:

- ✓ A photocopy of the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31)
- ✓ CDFW/ASB copies of all cash receipts (including all voided receipts)
- ✓ A copy of all CDFW No Effect Determinations filed in lieu of fee payment
- ✓ A copy of all NODs filed with the county during the preceding month
- ✓ A list of the name, address and telephone number of all project applicants for which an NOD has been filed. If this information is contained on the cash receipt filed with CDFW under California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 753.5, subdivision (e)(6), no additional information is required.

DOCUMENT RETENTION

The county shall retain two copies of the cash receipt (for lead agency and county clerk) and a copy of all documents described above for at least 12 months.

RECEIPT NUMBER

- # The first two digits automatically populate by making the appropriate selection in the County/State Agency of Filing drop down menu.
- # The next eight digits automatically populate when a date is entered.
- # The last three digits correspond with the sequential order of issuance for each calendar year. For example, the first receipt number issued on January 1 should end in 001. If a county issued 252 receipts for the year ending on December 31, the last receipt number should end in 252. CDFW recommends that counties and state agencies 1) save a local copy of this form, and 2) track receipt numbers on a spreadsheet tabbed by month to ensure accuracy.
