Please provide a Project Description (Proposed Actions, location, and/or consequences).

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing to widen three bridges in Ventura County on State Route 1 at Willow/Los Sauces Creek (Bridge No. 52-0003, post mile 28.15) and on State Route 33 at North Fork Matilija Creek (Bridge No. 52-0044, post mile 16.13 and Bridge No. 52-0173, post mile 15.82). The bridges would be widened to upgrade non-standard wooden bridge railing and accommodate standard 8-foot paved shoulders at all locations. Additional lanes are not proposed.

Please identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The project Build Alternative has potential to affect designated critical habitat for California red-legged frog. Mitigation measures include establishment of Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) fencing. Compensatory mitigation for critical habitat will be conducted both on and off-site in anticipation of permit conditions from California Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) and California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW).
