

**Project Title:** Atlantic Street On-ramp Widening Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0052-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located between post miles 2.6 and 3.1 at Atlantic Street/Eureka Boulevard/I-80 on-ramp, at Miners Ravine in the County of Placer, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0052-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.
