Project Title: Summit Creek Bridge Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0490-R1)

Project Location (Trinity): The project is located on Summit Creek near the community of Hayfork in Trinity County; Township 32N, Range 11W, Section 36; 14840 State Highway 3; APN 015-050-024-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2019-0490-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Anzor Davydov.

An existing eight-foot diameter culvert washed out in February 2019 and will be replaced in the same location with a twenty foot long, thirteen feet wide rail car-type structure placed on concrete abutments. The abutments will be armored with approximately 25 cubic yards of rip-rap. An existing low water crossing approximately 250-feet downstream will be used for temporary construction access. All work will be performed when the channel is dry. There will be a loss of up to 200 square feet of riparian vegetation for construction access.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 26, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
- CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
