Project Location (Trinity): The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Tule Creek in Trinity County, CA; T31N, R12W, section 16, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, Hayfork U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle, Trinity County Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 016-170-61-00, 11 Hunter Lane, Hayfork.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2020-0002-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Aco Rakacevic**.

The proposed Project consists of the decommissioning and removal of an impoundment of an unnamed ephemeral tributary of Tule Creek. The existing pond holds approximately 10,000 gallons of water from November to May. The earthen berm forming the dam is comprised of approximately 1,900 cubic yards of soil.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on December 2, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
