**Project Location:** The proposed Project will be located at 7763 Avenue 280, Visalia, CA, on the south side of Avenue 280 and east of Road 76. The site is approximately 0.65 miles west of State Route 99. The approximately 20-acre site is located on Tulare County APN 119-010-039. The site is within the Goshen 7.5 Minute USGS Quadrangle and lies within Section 8, Township 19S, Range 24E, MDB&M.

**Project Description:** The Applicant is pursuing a Special Use Permit (PSP 18-049) through Tulare County for the following: 1) a concrete batch plant that would produce 100,000 tons of concrete per year for commercial and retail sale; 2) a hot-mix asphalt (HMA) batch plant that would produce 150,000 tons of HMA per year for commercial and retail sale; and 3) recycling of 30,000 tons per year of concrete and asphalt to be crushed into recycle base.
