Project Title: Solano 4 Wind Project

Project Location (Solano): Project activities are generally located at five unnamed channels near Montezuma Hills Road and Toland Lane in the City of Rio Vista, County of Solano, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0318-R3 pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD).

Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) technique will be used to install 10-inch diameter high-density polyethylene (HDPE) casings and a new feeder circuit below four (4) unnamed drainages. The launching and receiving pits will each measure approximately 25 square feet (5 feet wide by 5 feet long). All HDD activities will occur at a minimum depth of approximately four to eleven feet below the ground surface.

Additionally, the project involves installation of a new stream crossing, which will allow for transportation of decommissioned turbines off the site and new turbines onto the site for installation. The stream crossing will be in place for a maximum of 18 months while project activities are being conducted.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 9, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
- 2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
