**Project Title:** Tisdale Road Bridge Replacement (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit (ITP) No. 2081-2020-003-02) Amendment 1

**Project Location**: This Project is located in the Westside Canal, off Tisdale Road, in the County of Sutter, State of California, Latitude 39.023924, Longitude -121.816061.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is approving an Amendment to the ITP that includes an update to the Principal Officer's title and agency name, a reduction in the permanent and temporary impacts to GGS habitat, and an update to the corresponding mitigation and cost estimates.

The project will result in the permanent loss of 0.13-acres and temporary loss of 0.03-acres of giant garter snake (Thamnophis gigas) habitat. The Project is expected to result in incidental take of giant garter snake which is designated as a threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
