Project Title: Utility Underground District No. 48 (Berkeley, CA)

Project Location - Grizzly Peak Boulevard between Hill Road and southeastern City Limit; Summit Road between Atlas Place and the southeastern City Limit; Summit Lane; Senior Avenue; Avenida Drive between Queens Road and Grizzly Peak Boulevard; in the City of Berkeley, CA (See attached Map)

## Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

PG&E, Comcast and AT&T will place their utility lines from overhead to underground to enhace the aesthetics of the community and create a general public benefit within the established Undeground Utility District (UUD) No. 48 boundary in the area of Grizzly Peak Blyd. and Summit Road, more specifically along Grizzly Peak Boulevard between Hill Road and southeastern City Limit; Summit Road between Atlas Place and Grizzly Peak Blyd; Summit Road from Grizzly Peak Blvd to 1545 Summit Road; Summit Lane; Senior Avenue; Avenida Drive between Queens Road and Grizzly Peak Boulevard. The Project consists of relocation of overhead utilities either into a main trench within the roadway or to the side of the roadway within the City right-of-way within the UUD boundary. Existing utility poles within the Underground Utility District boundary will be removed. Where these poles support a street light, a new streetlight pole will be installed in its place. The project will benefit 175 parcels along approximately 7000 linear feet of roadway centerline within the boundary of UUD No. 48. It is anticipated that there will be 15 retaining walls installed within right of way in front of private property and 4 retaining walls installed on private property, 3 easements required, and approximately 13 non-heritage trees removed to provide room for above ground or subsurface utility structures, or access for the inspection and maintenance of public utility facilities.
