Title: Request for a Letter of Non-Objection to Enter State Sovereign Land to Conduct a Master's Research Project through California State University, Northridge, in Various Locations in Los Angeles and Orange Counties

Location: State Sovereign land in the Pacific Ocean near the cities of Malibu, Corona del Mar, Long Beach, Newport, and San Pedro, in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

Description: Authorize approval to enter State sovereign land to conduct a Master's Research Project, through California State University, Northridge (CSUN), to install data collection instruments and collect specimens in tide pools, at several locations near the cities of Malibu, Corona del Mar, Long Beach, Newport Beach, and San Pedro. The purpose of the Project is to study the impacts of foundation species of California mussels and macroalgae on species interaction, biogeochemistry, and ecosystem function.
