Project Location: The proposed project will occur at the northern side of Freedom Boulevard at 7200 Freedom Boulevard, Aptos, CA 95001 in the County of Santa Cruz; Assessor's Parcel Number 041-242-21.

Brief Project Description: The proposed project consists of the replacement of Central Water District well #4 and #10 with a new well. The proposed new well will consist of the construction of a 600-foot deep 12-inch diameter well casing, well pump station, electrical system, and an 8-inch diameter pipeline to the existing water distribution system of Central Water District, Aptos, CA.

The proposed 8-inch pipeline will connect to an existing pipeline along Freedom Blvd. and run approximately 900 feet in a buried trench to the new building that will house the electrical systems and a chlorine solution tank and pump.

The well site will be graded with a slight slope and will result in the removal of approximately 100 cubic yards of soil. The well will be located outside the building with a 24-inch square concrete pedestal and will contain a submersible pump with a capacity of approximately 500 gallons per minute.

Determination: Based on a review of the Project as proposed, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees [Fish and Game Code 711.4(c)] the project has potential effects on fish, wildlife and habitat and the project as described REQUIRES payment of a CEQA filing fee. At the time of filing of the NOD with the County Clerk, the appropriate CEQA filing fee will be due and payable.

This determination does not determine the significance of any potential project effects evaluated pursuant to CEQA.
